

Connecticut's Merchandise Exports to Mexico




- Since 1993, Connecticut's exports to Mexico have increased by 235%.
- Mexico accounted for 7.4% of Connecticut's exports worldwide in 2016.
- Top Export Industries:
 Chemicals (24%), Electrical Equipment (17%), Primary Metal Manufacturing (16%), Machinery (12%), & Computer & Electronic Products (8%).
- Mexican investment supports 440 jobs in Connecticut. For instance, Grupo Bimbo the largest baked goods company in the world, employs 150 people in Stamford.
