- Trade with Mexico supports 200,200 jobs.
- In 2016, Mexico was the 2nd largest export market for Illinois.
- Exports to Mexico totaled 9.5 billion USD in 2016.



- Since 1993, Illinois' exports to Mexico have grown 703%.
- Mexico accounted for 16% of Illinois' exports worldwide in 2016.
- Top Export Industries: Transportation Equipment (18%), Computer & Electronic Products (14%), Machinery (11%), Chemicals (11%), & Electrical Equipment (10%).
- Mexican investment supports 1,800 jobs in Illinois. For instance, Gruma Corporation, a corn flour and tortilla company, employs 340 people in Palos Heights.
