- Trade with Mexico supports 23,300 jobs.
- In 2016, Mexico was the 3rd largest export market for West Virginia.
- Exports to Mexico totaled 179 million USD in 2016.



- Since 1993, West Virginia's exports to Mexico have increased by 378%.
- Mexico accounted for 3.6% of West Virgina's exports worldwide in 2016.
- Top Export Industries: Chemicals (45%), Minerals & Ores (23%), Transportation Equipment (9%), Primary Metal Manufacturing (8%), & Machinery (3%).
- Mexican investment supports nearly 400 jobs in West Virginia. For instance, Grupo Bimbo, the largest baked goods company in the world, employs 200 people in Huntington.
